### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §1604, sub-§1, ¶B, as amended by PL 1989, c. 503, Pt. B, §112, is further amended to read:

B. Nine <u>Fifteen</u> individuals who have experience with the problems of displaced homemakers, -career counseling or -adult vecational -education entering, reentering or retraining for the paid workforce or starting a small business. The members shall be are appointed by the Governor. The council shall elect its own chair.

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#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill increases the number of individuals and broadens the expertise of the members of the Displaced Homemakers Advisory Council.
