**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

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**Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §652, sub-§1**, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683,  
4 Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

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**1. United States' vehicle.** A vehicle owned by the Federal  
Government, unless it is registered in this State or a vehicle  
8 owned by the Federal Government that is loaned to the State or a  
municipality for forest fire control activities;

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**STATEMENT OF FACT**

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This bill provides that a certificate of title or a  
certificate of salvage is not required for a vehicle owned by the  
16 Federal Government that is loaned to the State or a municipality  
for forest fire control activities.
