2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA $\S7824$, sub- $\S2$, as amended by PL 1991, c. 477 $\S1$, is further amended to read:
6	2. Fee. The annual snowmobile registration fee is \$20 \$35.
8	Sec. 2. 12 MRSA $\S7824$, sub- $\S3$, \PA , as amended by PL 1991, c 477, $\S2$, is further amended to read:
10	A. The registration fee for residents is credited as follows:
14	(1) \$4.75 Five dollars of each fee is credited to the General Fund as undedicated revenue;

18	(2) \$9.25 <u>Twenty-four dollars</u> of each fee is credited to the Snowmobile Trail Fund of the Department of Conservation, Bureau of Parks and Recreation; and

4	This bill raises the annual snowmobile registration fee to \$35 and credits the proceeds for each fee paid by a state
6	resident as follows:
8	1. \$5 to the General Fund as undedicated revenue;
10	2. \$24 to the Snowmobile Trail Fund of the Department of Conservation, Bureau of Parks and Recreation; and
12 14	3. \$6 to the municipality of the owner's residence.
16	The fee paid by a nonresident is credited as follows:
18	1. \$5 to the General Fund as undedicated revenue; and
20	2. \$30 to the Snowmobile Trail Fund.
