Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4       **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7824, sub-§2**, as amended by PL 1991, c. 477,  
§1, is further amended to read:

6       **2. Fee.** The annual snowmobile registration fee is \$20 ~~\$35~~.

8       **Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7824, sub-§3, ¶A**, as amended by PL 1991, c.  
10 477, §2, is further amended to read:

12       A. The registration fee for residents is credited as  
follows:

14               (1) ~~\$4.75~~ Five dollars of each fee is credited to the  
16 General Fund as undedicated revenue;

18               (2) ~~\$9.25~~ Twenty-four dollars of each fee is credited  
to the Snowmobile Trail Fund of the Department of  
20 Conservation, Bureau of Parks and Recreation; and

22               (3) ~~\$6~~ Six dollars of each fee is annually distributed  
to the municipality of the owner's residence as shown  
24 on the owner's registration certificate, except that in  
unorganized territory, \$6 of each fee is annually  
26 distributed to the county of the owner's residence as  
shown on the owner's registration certificate and  
28 credited to the unorganized territory fund of that  
county established in Title 30-A, section 7502.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill raises the annual snowmobile registration fee to \$35 and credits the proceeds for each fee paid by a state resident as follows:

1. \$5 to the General Fund as undedicated revenue;

2. \$24 to the Snowmobile Trail Fund of the Department of Conservation, Bureau of Parks and Recreation; and

3. \$6 to the municipality of the owner's residence.

The fee paid by a nonresident is credited as follows:

1. \$5 to the General Fund as undedicated revenue; and

2. \$30 to the Snowmobile Trail Fund.
