SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 382, L.D. 1059, "Resolve, to Establish a Paper Industry Council"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the first indented paragraph after the title the following:

'Further amend the resolve in section 7 in the next to the last line (page 2, line 41 in L.D) by inserting after the following: "expenses" the following: ', upon application to the Executive Director of the Legislative Council' '

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the 2nd, 3rd and 4th indented paragraphs after the title (page 1, lines 26 to 49 and page 2, lines 1 to 6 in amendment).

FISCAL NOTE

The amendment removes the need for the General Fund appropriation to the Department of Economic and Community Development. The Legislature can absorb the costs of reimbursing the per diem and expenses of legislative members of the Paper Industry Council.
