Amend the resolve in section 2 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 33 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "following:" the following: 'the Department of Conservation,'

Further amend the resolve in section 10 in the last line (page 3, line 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "activities." and inserting in its place the following: 'activities; and be it further'

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

'Sec. 11. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this resolve.

APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS

General Fund \$1,260 \$1,680

The Department of Economic and Community Development will require additional General Fund appropriations of \$1,260 and \$1,680 in fiscal years 1995-96 and 1996-97, respectively, for the per diem and expenses of the legislative members of the Paper Industry Council.

The additional costs to provide staffing and clerical assistance to the council can be absorbed by the Department of Economic and Community Development utilizing existing budgeted resources.

The minor additional costs associated with participation on the council can be absorbed within the existing budgeted resources of the member state departments and agencies.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds a representative of the Department of Conservation to the Paper Industry Council which is created by the resolve.

This amendment also adds an appropriation section and a fiscal note to the resolve.
