COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 384, L.D. 1061, Bill, "An Act to Amend Certain Provisions of the Law Relating to Defense"

Amend the bill in Part A in section 1 in subsection 3 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 10 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "officer's" and inserting in its place the following: '~~officer's~~ individual's'

Further amend the bill in Part C in section 1 in subsection 2 by striking out all of the last underlined sentence (page 3, lines 26 to 28 in L.D.).

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment changes the word "officer's" to the word "individual's" to ensure that the law applies to enlisted personnel as well as officers. It also permits a current state employee to serve as a deputy adjutant general.
