

**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4       **Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §1015, sub-§2**, as enacted by PL 1985, c.  
161, §6, is amended to read:

8       **2. Committees; corporations; associations.** No political  
10       committee, other committee, corporation or association may make  
12       contributions to a candidate, in support of the candidacy of one  
14       person, aggregating more than \$5,000 in any election, except an  
election for a State Legislator. In a primary or general  
election for a State Legislator, a political committee, other  
committee, corporation or association may not make a contribution  
aggregating more than \$500.
