2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §656, sub-§1, ¶E**, as amended by PL 1989, c.
890, Pt. A, §9 and affected by §40, is further amended by
6 amending subparagraph (1) to read:

8 E. Pollution control facilities.

10 (1) Water pollution control facilities having a
12 capacity to handle at least 4,000 gallons of waste per
14 day, prior to discharge of the waste into the
environment, certified as such by the Commissioner of
Environmental Protection, and all parts and accessories
thereof.

16 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

18 This bill amends the law regarding tax exemptions for water
20 pollution control facilities by clarifying the capacity of the
facility to handle waste.
