4 **Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §601, sub-§2, ¶F,** as enacted by PL 1987, c.
45, Pt. A, §4, is amended to read:

6 F. A full-time law enforcement officer benefits financially
8 either directly or indirectly;

10 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

12 This bill limits the restriction against law enforcement
14 officers obtaining a liquor license to full-time law enforcement
officers, thereby, permitting part-time law enforcement officers
to be eligible for a license.
