COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 407, L.D. 1095

<u>C. Attend a political convention, rally, fund-raising</u> function or other political gathering; and

4 <u>D. Make financial contribution to a political party,</u>
<u>partisan political group or to the campaign committee of a</u>
6 <u>candidate for partisan political office.</u>

 7. Candidacy for elective office. An officer or employee in the classified service of this State may not be a candidate
for elective office in a partisan public election other than for a local office. Law enforcement officers continue to be subject
to departmental rules regarding procedures on candidacy for elective partisan office.'
