HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 409, L.D. 1097, "Resolve, to Establish the Task Force to Study Environmental Regulation"

Amend the amendment by inserting after subsection 1, paragraph B the following:

'Further amend the resolve in section 10 in the last line (page 3, line 49 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "." and inserting in its place the following: '; and be it further'

Further amend the resolve by inserting after section 10 the following:

'Sec. 11. Allocation. Resolved: The following funds are allocated from Other Special Revenue funds to carry out the purposes of this resolve.

16 The Department of Economic and Community Development will
18 incur some minor additional costs to provide staffing and
clerical support to the Task Force to Study Environmental

absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.

22 The Department of Environmental Protection and the
24 Department of Economic and Community Development will incur some
minor additional costs to participate as members of the task
26 force. These costs can be absorbed within the departments'
existing budgeted resources.

28 The bill additionally provides an allocation of Other
30 Special Revenue funds of \$500 in fiscal year 1995-96 to the
Department of Economic and Community Development to provide
32 expenditure authority if public or private funds are received to
support activities of the task force.'

38 This amendment adds an allocation section to the resolve to
authorize expenditures of funds from private or public sources in
40 the event that the Task Force to Study Environmental Regulation
Relating to the Paper Industry raises funds from outside
