28	Amend the resolve in that part designated "Sec. 5." by striking out all of subsection 1 and inserting in its place the
30	following:
32	'1. Environmental regulations. In terms of environmental regulations, the task force shall:
34	A. Determine which state statutory standards and regulatory
36	standards, interpretations or other requirements that relate to the paper industry exceed or are inconsistent with
38	federal requirements; and
40	B. For those requirements that exceed the federal requirements, obtain data to compare them, as a minimum, to
42	the 5 leading paper industry states.'
44	Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

50	The Department of Economic and Community Development will incur some minor additional costs to provide staffing and

STATEMENT OF FACT

14 amendment broadens the scope of the study from The environmental standards to environmental requirements, whether 16 the requirements are standards, interpretations or other requirements. It also requires the study to include examination of state requirements that are inconsistent with 18 federal requirements. Finally, the amendment adds a fiscal note to the 20 resolve and changes the title of the resolve to clarify that it applies to environmental regulation of the paper industry.
