The amendment increases from \$60,000 to \$80,000 the amount of money the Department of Transportation can annually spend on the maintenance of roads in Baxter State Park. It also deletes a portion of law that allows the department to spend \$20,000 on Baxter State Park road maintenance for every gate that provides public ingress and egress to the park, up to a maximum of \$60,000 annually.

The amendment also changes the title of the bill and adds a fiscal note.
