2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §3007, sub-§5** is enacted to read:

6 **5. Firearms and bows and arrows.** Municipalities may not
8 include bows and arrows in any firearms discharge ordinances and
10 must remove any inclusion in any current ordinance.

12 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

14 This bill directs municipalities to not include bows and
16 arrows in any firearms discharge ordinances they enact and
requires them to remove bows and arrows from any current firearms
discharge ordinances.
