COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 787, L.D. 1104, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Structure of the Electricians' Examining Board"

Amend the bill in section 1 in the first paragraph in the 3rd line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "7 8" and inserting in its place the following: '7'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in the 2nd paragraph in the first line (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "7 8" and inserting in its place the following: '7'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in the 2nd paragraph in the 2nd line (page 1, line 14 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "electrician;" and inserting in its place the following: 'electrician experienced in low-energy electronics;'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in the 2nd paragraph in the 3rd and 4th lines (page 1, lines 15 and 16 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "one person licensed and experienced in low-energy electronics;"

STATEMENT OF FACT

The bill requires the addition of a person with a limited low-energy electronics license to the Electricians' Examining Board. This amendment eliminates that provision and requires that the current master electrician member be experienced in low-energy electronics.
