SENATE AMENDMENT " " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 788,

terminates an indemnity agreement executed after the effective date of this section as to any indemnitor to whom the annual notice was not sent. In no event does failure to send an annual notice or termination of the indemnity agreement relieve an indemnitor or the indemnitors' heirs, successors or assigns from past, present or future liability arising under any such bond executed in reliance upon the indemnity agreement if that indemnity agreement was in effect at the time the bond was executed.'

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment, which incorporates the substance of Senate Amendment "B" to Committee Amendment "A," requires that notification of indemnity agreements made in connection with performance or payment bonds be made on an annual basis to indemnitors who are residents of the State and who indemnify bonds executed by corporations of this State. Notification must also be made to an indemnitor who is a principal on the bond. This amendment deletes the language that requires agents, brokers or sureties to provide a copy of the annual notice of the existence of an indemnity agreement to the person or persons executing the bond.
