	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the
2	Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
4	Whereas, Raymond and Kathryn Savage of Calais were entitled
6	to a refund of income taxes in the amount of \$1,703 over the years 1985 to 1987; and
8	Whereas, the Bureau of Taxation has denied the Savages a
10	refund because their request was not filed within statutory time frames; and
12	Whereas, the failure of the Savages to file for a refund
14	within the statutory time frames was through no fault of the Savages; and
16	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
18	create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
20	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it
22	Sec. 1. Payment by Bureau of Taxation. Resolved: That Raymond
24	and Kathryn Savage of Calais be paid the amount of the income tax refunds that they would have received for tax years 1985 to 1987
26	if their request had been received in a timely manner. The Bureau of Taxation shall compute the amount owed and pay the
28	Savages within 30 days after the effective date of this resolve.
30	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve takes effect when approved.
