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HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 797, L.D. 1114, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Law Regarding the Possession of Short Lobsters"

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Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "~~S~~6402-B." in the first paragraph by striking out the last 4 lines (page 1, lines 39 to 42 amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

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'occurred after July 1, 1994. The suspension is for a period of 3 years from the date of conviction.'

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Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the fiscal note and replacing it with the following:

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**FISCAL NOTE**

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The Department of Marine Resources will incur some minor additional costs to administer and enforce certain requirements governing the suspension of lobster and crab fishing licenses for the possession of short lobsters. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'


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**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment eliminates the change in the mandatory suspension period and retains the mandatory suspension period of 3 years.

The amendment also adds a fiscal note.
