24 26	<pre>§6402-B. Suspension based on 2 or more convictions of possessing short lobsters</pre>
28	Notwithstanding section 6401, subsection 2, the commissioner shall suspend the lobster and crab fishing license of any
30	licenseholder <u>license holder</u> convicted of a 2nd or subsequent offense of possessing a lobster smaller than the minimum size
32	established in section 6431, subsection 1 if the conviction of the 2nd or subsequent offense involved possession of 3 or more
34	lobsters smaller than that minimum size. The-suspension-is-for-a period-of-3-years-from-the-date-of-conviction.
36	1. Second offense. For a 2nd conviction the commissioner
38	shall suspend the license for at least one year from the date of conviction and may suspend the license for up to 3 years.

HOUSE AMENDMENT """ to H.P. 797, L.D. 1114

3. Offenses after July 1, 1994. Subsections 1 and 2 apply 2 only if that person's first conviction for possessing a lobster smaller than the minimum size established in section 6431, subsection 1 was for an offense that occurred after July 1, 1994. 4 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the 6 statement of fact the following: 8 10 **'FISCAL NOTE** 12 Changes in the length of certain mandatory suspensions for lobster and crab fishing licenses may result in insignificant increases of General Fund revenue from license fees.' 14 16 STATEMENT OF FACT 18 The amendment replaces the language of the original bill. It amends the law concerning the mandatory suspension of a 20 lobster and crab fishing license when a license holder is 22 convicted of a 2nd or subsequent offense of possessing short lobsters. The mandatory suspension has been changed to include a 24 minimum suspension of one year and no more than 3 years for a 2nd offense and a suspension of 3 years or a permanent license 26 revocation for a 3rd subsequent offense if the conviction involves the possession of 3 or more short lobsters.
