The bill increases the portion of gasoline tax allocated to the Snowmobile Trail Fund and the ATV Recreational Management Fund administered by the Department of Conservation. This transfer of tax revenues on internal combustion engine fuel will reduce Highway Fund revenue by \$402,211 and \$562,533 in fiscal years 1995-96 and 1996-97, respectively, and increase General Fund revenue and dedicated revenue to the Snowmobile Trail Fund and the ATV Recreational Management Fund.

The estimated increases of General Fund revenue are \$18,903 and \$26,646 in fiscal years 1995-96 and 1996-97, respectively. These funds are to be used by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife for the administration of law enforcement, registration and safety training programs. The bill includes additional General Fund appropriations of the same amounts for each of the corresponding fiscal years.

The estimated increases of dedicated revenue to the Snowmobile Trail Fund and ATV Recreational Management Fund within the Department of Conservation are \$383,308 and \$535,887 in fiscal years 1995-96 and 1996-97, respectively. This bill includes total dedicated revenue allocations of the same amounts for each of the corresponding fiscal years.'

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

3.8

This amendment adjusts the allocations to the Department of Conservation and includes appropriations to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. The appropriation is necessary to comply with the provisions of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 36, section 2903-B, which requires that 10% of the allocations to the Snowmobile Trail Fund be directed to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife.
