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| 2 | Sec. 1. 7 MRSA c. 103, sub-c. VII-A is enacted to read: |
| 4 6 | SUBCHAPTER VII-A |
| 8 | FROZEN FOODS |
| 10 | §841. Previously frozen food; labeling |
| 12 | All previously frozen food sold in this State must be labeled by the retailer as being previously frozen. |
| 14 | §842. Violation |
| 16 | <u>A retailer who fails to comply with the provisions of section 841 commits a civil violation for which a forfeiture of</u> |
| 18 | not more than \$100 may be adjudged. |
| 20 | STATEMENT OF FACT |
| 22 | This bill requires a retailer to label previously frozen |
| 24 | foods as being previously frozen. |

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
