2 **Sec. 1. Sportsmen Policing Our Ranks Together. Resolved:** That
the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall develop a
4 program, modeled on Pennsylvania's SPORT program, to combat
disrespect and misconduct and to improve the hunter's image. The
6 program must operate within the Department of Inland Fisheries
and Wildlife's Division of Information and Education. The
8 program must be implemented by January 1, 1997.

12 This resolve directs the Department of Inland Fisheries and
Wildlife to develop the Sportsmen Policing Our Ranks Together
