COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 413, L.D. 1136, Bill, "An Act to Provide Immunity for Clinicians Contracted by the State Forensic Service"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill may decrease the number of civil suits filed in the court system. The Judicial Department may realize some minor savings from reductions of workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of cases that will no longer be filed. Reductions in the collection of filing fees may decrease General Fund revenue by minor amounts.

The net fiscal impact of this change in the status of certain clinicians contracting with the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation can not be determined but is expected to be insignificant.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
