Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §752-C, as amended by PL 1993, c. 176, §1, is 4 further amended to read:

6 §752-C. Sexual acts towards minors

Actions based upon sexual intercourse, as defined in Title 8 17-A, section 556, subsection 1-B, or a sexual act, as defined in 10 Title 17-A, chapter 11, with a person who is 16 years of age or older and under the age of majority must be commenced within 12 years after the cause of action accrues, or within 6 years of the 12 time the person discovers or reasonably should have discovered the harm, whichever occurs later. 14 Actions based on sexual intercourse, as defined in Title 17-A, section 556, subsection 1-B, or a sexual act, as defined in Title 17-A, chapter 11, with 16 a person who is under 16 years of age may be commenced at any time after the cause of action accrues. 18

22 STATEMENT OF FACT

24 This bill eliminates the statute of limitations for civil actions based on sexual intercourse or sexual acts with minors 26 under the age of 16 years.
