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Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §765, as amended by PL 1993, c. 227, §2, is further amended to read:

§765. Budget estimate; submission to advisory committee

The Hancock County commissioners shall submit a budget estimate to the budget advisory committee no later than October 1st for the coming year. The budget advisory committee shall review the budget estimate and make recommendations to the commissioners before November 15th. In order to deviate from any recommendation made by the budget advisory committee, the county commissioners must unanimously approve that change. The county commissioners shall act on the budget no later than December 15th of the budget year.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill requires that any changes to the recommendations made by the Hancock County Budget Advisory Committee receive unanimous approval by the Hancock County commissioners.

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
