2	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§47, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 855,
4	§7, is amended to read:
б	47. Emergency shelter and feeding organizations. Sales of householdandsanitarysupplies to incorporated nonprofit
8	organizations which that provide free temporary emergency shelter or food for underpriviledged individuals in this State.

12	STATEMENT OF FACT

	Under current law, only the sales "of household and sanitary
16	supplies" to emergency shelter and feeding organizations are exempt from taxation. This bill removes that limitation and
18	extends the existing exemption to all sales to emergency shelter and feeding organizations.
