SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 841, L.D. 1172, Bill, "An Act to Increase Moose Hunting Permit Application Fees"

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the title and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the following:

'Sec. 3. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.



Increasing moose hunting permit and application fees for nonresidents and aliens will increase annual General Fund revenue by \$215,600 annually beginning in fiscal year 1995-96.

To meet the requirements of the Constitution of Maine, this bill includes General Fund appropriations of \$215,600 annually in fiscal years 1995-96 and 1996-97 to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife for additional enforcement efforts.' '
