COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 841, L.D. 1172, Bill, "An Act to Increase Moose Hunting Permit Application Fees"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

General Fund	\$215,600	\$215,600

Increasing moose hunting permit and application fees for nonresidents and aliens will increase annual General Fund revenue by \$215,600 annually beginning in fiscal year 1995-96. These increases of General Fund revenue collected by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife may require additional General Fund appropriations to the department pursuant to the Constitution of Maine. The amounts will depend on the total General Fund appropriations to the department and the revenue generated by the department which will be determined by final legislative actions on the current services budget and other legislation during the First Regular Session of the 117th Legislature.'
