30	Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

36	The additional costs to record reports from nonhospital health care facilities in the Maine Cancer Registry can be absorbed by the Department of Human Services utilizing existing

40	STATEMENT OF FACT

44	This amendment exempts from the reporting requirements health care practitioners who provide treatment by spiritual means alone. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
