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HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 846, L.D. 1177, Bill, "An Act to Enable the Department of Corrections to Share Information with Canadian Criminal Justice Agencies"

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Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 4 in the last line (page 1, line 14 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "government" and inserting in its place the following: 'Government'

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Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

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'Sec. 2. Effective date; contingent on Canadian Government action.
This Act takes effect only when the United States Attorney for the District of Maine certifies that the Canadian Government allows citizens of the United States to enter Canada on the same basis as the United States Government allows citizens of Canada to enter the United States.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT


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This amendment makes the bill effective contingent upon the Canadian Government allowing the entry of United States citizens into Canada on the same basis as Canadian citizens are allowed entry into the United States.
