An Act to Establish a Moose Lottery Point System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7463-A, sub-§14 is enacted to read: 4 14. Point system for public chance drawing. The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall develop a point system for 6 applicants for use beginning with the 1996 public chance drawing. This point system gives an applicant for a permit one 8 point for each year the applicant applies for a permit, beginning in 1996. If an unsuccessful applicant applies for a permit in a 10 following year, the applicant receives one additional point for each year the applicant applies until the applicant's name is 12 selected at the public chance drawing. The next time a successful applicant applies for a permit, the successful 14applicant receives one point and may accumulate points if unsuccessful. Each point entitles the applicant to one chance in 16 the public chance drawing. Applicants may accumulate an unlimited number of points. 18 20 STATEMENT OF FACT 22 This bill directs the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to change the moose lottery to give applicants who were 24

unsuccessful in previous lotteries a better chance of winning.
