COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 852, L.D. 1183, Bill, "An Act to Authorize the Issuance of a Credit Card to Benefit the Land for Maine's Future Fund"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. Allocation. The following funds are allocated from Other Special Revenue to carry out the purposes of this Act.

This bill includes Other Special Revenue allocations of \$50,000 and \$75,000 in fiscal years 1995-96 and 1996-97, respectively, to the Land for Maine's Future program for land acquisitions. These allocations are based on estimates of the additional dedicated revenue generated by the credit card program. The actual amounts of dedicated revenue may vary significantly depending on the terms of the contract and the demand for the card.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment corrects the line category in the allocation section from "All Other" to "Capital Expenditures" and changes the allocation in fiscal year 1995-96 from \$75,000 to \$50,000. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
