28	This bill may increase prosecutions for Class E crimes. If a jail sentence is imposed, the additional costs to the counties
30	are estimated to be \$83.22 per day for each offender. These costs are not reimbursed by the State. The number of
32	prosecutions that may result in a jail sentence and the resulting costs to the county jail system are expected to be insignificant.
34	The additional workload and administrative costs associated
36	with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial
38	Department. The collection of additional fines may increase
40	General Fund revenue by minor amounts.
12	The additional enforcement costs can be absorbed by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife utilizing existing
