	The original bill requires that a dealer require a buyer to
30	sign for receipt of the disclosure statement that must accompany
32	the sale of a used automobile and keep the receipt for 2 years.
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This amendment changes the retention requirement to conform

with the requirements of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 29-A, section 956 which deals with the retention of all such records.
