COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " to H.P. 863, L.D. 1194

If approved by the voters, the Legislature would realize General Fund savings beginning in fiscal year 2002-03. These savings, resulting from reductions of Legislators' salaries and benefits, travel and constituent allowances and legislative staff, would be approximately \$2,000,000 for a first regular session and \$1,500,000 for a second regular session.'
