actual cost. It requires department personnel to use a double
gauge lobster measure that is certified for accuracy by the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources, Office of
Sealer of Weights and Measures. It also requires that any measurement used to substantiate a violation of the Maine Revised
Statutes, Title 12, section 6431 must be made with a certified double gauge lobster measure.

The amendment also adds an appropriation section and a fiscal note to the bill.
