Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §§6303 and 6304 are enacted to read: 4 6303. Authority to inspect school buildings 6 The Department of Human Services, Bureau of Health, shall inspect school buildings that are subject to basic school 8 approval under section 4502 to monitor compliance with air 10 quality and other health standards established by the commissioner. Inspections may be conducted by an agent of the 12 bureau upon presentation of appropriate credentials to the office of the superintendent or principal. The bureau may inspect during regular working hours, at other reasonable times, within 14reasonable limits and in a reasonable manner, any school building subject to this section. The bureau may conduct inspections 16 without advance notice. 18 6304. Rules authorized 20 The commissioner shall adopt rules necessary for the effective implementation of this subchapter. 22 24 STATEMENT OF FACT 26 This bill requires the Department of Human Services, Bureau 28 of Health, to ensure that school buildings meet basic air quality and other health standards similar to the health standards applicable to private business. 30
