## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6024, sub-§1-A, as amended by PL 1989, c. 788, §1, is further amended to read:

Marine Resources Advisory Council, established by Title section 12004-G, subsection 27, shall-consist consists of 9 15 8 The Chair of the Lobster Advisory Council shall-be is 10 an ex officio member of the council. Each 26 member must represent a different commercial harvesting activity, except that none of those 7 members may represent lobster harvesters. The remaining 7 members must include one person who 28 represents recreational marine fishing interests, one public 30 member, 4 persons who hold a nonharvesting-related license under this Part and one person representing the aquaculture industry. The Governor shall select the person to represent the aquaculture 32 industry from among the names recommended by the aquaculture industry. The composition of the council shall must reflect a 34 geographical distribution along the coast. All appointed members shall-be are appointed for a term of 3 years, except a vacancy 36 shall must be filled in the same manner as an original member for 38 the unexpired portion of the term.
