SENATE AMENDMENT " C " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 867, L.D. 1217, "An Act to Protect Constitutional Property Rights and to Provide Just Compensation"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 27 in amendment) by striking out the following: "20" and inserting in its place the following: '24'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 by striking out all of paragraphs G, H and I and inserting in their place the following:

'G. Five members of the Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary, appointed jointly by the Senate Chair and the House Chair. The 5 members of the Judiciary Committee shall choose from one of its members to serve as chair of the commission; and

H. Two members of the Joint Standing Committee on Natural Resources, 2 members of the Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry, 2 members of the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government and 2 members of the Joint Standing Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, appointed jointly by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives; and be it further'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 by renumbering paragraphs A to I to be subsections 1 to 8.

Further amend the amendment in section 4 by renumbering paragraphs A to H to be subsections 1 to 8.

STATEMENT OF FACT

4 This amendment changes the number of members to be appointed
6 from the Joint Standing Committee on Natural Resources, from the
8 Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and
10 Forestry, from the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local
12 Government and from the Joint Standing Committee on Inland
14 Fisheries and Wildlife from one member to 2 members and requires
16 that the selection of those members be made jointly by the
18 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
20 Representatives.

22 This amendment also corrects a format error.

24 This amendment reduces the number of authorized public
26 hearings and reduces the General Fund appropriation.
