The Director of the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages and Lottery Operations shall calculate the amount of the annual General Fund revenue reduction associated with competition from video lottery terminals and report the amount to the Controller prior to the end of each fiscal year. The chair of the State Harness Racing Commission shall calculate the amount of the annual General Fund revenue loss associated with competition from video lottery terminals and report that amount to the State Controller prior to the end of each fiscal year.'
