2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §519, sub-§2**, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683,
Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

6 **2. Registration plate design.** The Secretary of State may
design a numerical registration plate with the letters "FF" as a
8 suffix and include an appropriate symbol or mark associated with
fire departments and firefighters.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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Current law authorizes the Secretary of State to design a
special firefighter registration plate for issuance to certified
16 firefighters. This bill directs the Secretary of State to
include an appropriate symbol or mark identified with
18 firefighters on the special firefighter plate. The purpose of
this change is to speed access of firefighters arriving in their
20 personal vehicles in emergency situations.
