- Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6601, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1989, c. 348,

 §5, is further amended to read:
- 2. Licensed activities. The holder of a shellfish license may fish for or take shellfish or possess, ship or transport within the state limits or sell shellstock the holder has taken. The-holder-may-also-shuck,-in-the-holder's-home,-shellfish-the holder-has-taken-and-sell-those-shucked-shellfish-from-that-home in-the-retail-trade. This license shall does not authorize the holder to fish for or take shellfish in violation of a municipal ordinance adopted pursuant to section 6671.

Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §6851, sub-§7 is enacted to read:

- 7. Cash purchase. Purchases made pursuant to the license issued under this section may not be made by cash.
- Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §6852, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 661, §5, is amended to read:
 - 3. License limited. A license shall may only authorize these activities at one establishment or with one vehicle. A license does not authorize the owner of an establishment to allow another person to use another vehicle to perform the activities allowed under the license.

Sec. 4. 12 MRSA §6852, sub-§5 is enacted to read:

- 5. Cash purchase. Purchases made pursuant to the license issued under this section may not be made by cash.
- Sec. 5. 12 MRSA §6854, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 661, §5, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to protect certified sellers of clams and sea urchins by prohibiting the shucking of shellfish in homes. The bill also clarifies that a license is limited to one vehicle and a person may not allow another person to use a different vehicle for the transportation of shellfish. The bill prohibits the purchase of shellfish by wholesalers and retailers by cash. When purchases are made by cash, there are no permanent records of the purchases.
