Sec. 1. 4 MRSA §1058 is enacted to read:

§1058. Dismissal of frivolous actions

If a person asks for leave to proceed in forma pauperis

By pursuant to the Maine Rules of Civil Procedure, Rule 91, the court shall examine the complaint or other paper to be filed and,

if the court finds that the action is frivolous, it shall dismiss the action without prejudice, unless within 7 days after the finding the plaintiff pays the filing fee to the clerk.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill allows the court to dismiss lawsuits filed by persons who ask for leave to proceed without liability for court fees or costs if the court finds that the action is frivolous.
