Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §403, as amended by PL 1995, c. 6, §1, is repealed.

Sec. 2. 38 MRSA c. 28, as amended, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Exemption from reformulated gasoline sales. 8 Commissioner of Environmental Protection shall petition the 10 United States Environmental Protection Agency to remove all counties in the State from the list of counties that must use reformulated gasoline. The 12 Protection shall study the economic effects 14 vehicles and machinery using reformulated gasoline and report its

findings to the Joint Standing Committee on Natural Resources by September 1, 1995.

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Sec. 4. Petition for removal from Ozone Transport Region. The Department of Environmental Protection shall provide to the Governor a petition that requests the removal of the State from the Ozone Transport Region established pursuant to the federal Clean Air Act, 42 United States Code, Section 7511c. petition must include all available data and the department shall develop other data as necessary to demonstrate that emissions from sources in the State do not significantly contribute to nonattainment of the federal ambient air quality standard for ozone anywhere in the Ozone Transport Region. The Governor shall submit the petition to the United States Environmental Protection Agency within 2 weeks of receiving the petition from the department.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill repeals the Motor Vehicle Emissions Testing Program, requires the Commissioner of Environmental Protection to petition the United States Environmental Protection Agency to remove Maine counties from the federal regulation requiring certain areas of the country to sell reformulated gasoline and requires the Department of Environmental Protection to prepare a petition for the Governor's signature sufficient to satisfy the United States Environmental Protection Agency's requirements to remove the State from the Ozone Transport Region created in the federal Clean Air Act, 42 United States Code, Section 7511c.
