COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to S.P. 475, L.D. 1271

These costs can be absorbed within the board's existing budgeted resources.

Changes in the licensure qualification requirements and the licensure fees charged by the State Board of Registration for
Professional Engineers may result in insignificant increases of dedicated revenue.'

## STATEMENT OF FACT

12 This is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Business and Economic Development.

The original bill removes the cap of \$40 on the registration 16 fee for engineers. This amendment places a cap of \$200 on this fee. 18

The amendment adds a provision that removes the liability 20 for negligence of engineers who volunteer their services in times of public emergency.

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The amendment also adds an allocation section and a fiscal 24 note to the bill.
