HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 475, L.D. 1271, Bill, "An Act to Revise and Add to the Laws Regulating the Practice of Professional Engineering"

Amend the bill in section 12 in that part designated "**§1353.**" in the 2nd paragraph in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 8, lines 12 and 13 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "~~by the board in an amount not to exceed \$40~~ in the rules adopted by the board" and inserting in its place the following: 'by the board in an amount not to exceed \$40 \$200'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 17 the following:

'**Sec. 18. Allocation.** The following funds are allocated from Other Special Revenue funds to carry out the purposes of this Act.

The State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers will require additional Other Special Revenue allocations of \$750 and \$1,000 in fiscal years 1995-96 and 1996-97, respectively, for the additional costs of adding one member to the board. The board has sufficient dedicated revenue to cover this additional cost.

The State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers will incur some minor additional costs to adopt certain rules. These costs can be absorbed within the board's existing budgeted resources.

Increasing the cap on license fees to \$200 may increase dedicated revenues collected by the State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers. The amounts can not be determined at this time.

Changes in the licensure qualification requirements for professional engineers may result in insignificant increases of dedicated revenue collected by the State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers.'
