# SENATE AMENDMENT



### SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 475, L.D. 1271

These	costs	can	be	absorbed	within	the	board's	existing	budgeted
resources.									

Increasing the cap on license fees to \$200 may increase dedicated revenues collected by State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers. The amounts can not be determined at this time.

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Changes in the licensure qualification requirements for professional engineers may result in insignificant increases of dedicated revenue collected by the State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers.'

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#### STATEMENT OF FACT

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The original bill removes the cap of \$40 on the registration fee for engineers. This amendment places a cap of \$200 on this fee.

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The amendment adds a provision that removes the liability for negligence of engineers who volunteer their services in times of public emergency.

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The amendment also adds an allocation section and a fiscal note to the bill.
