

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §3992** is enacted to read:

6 **§3992. Proof of ownership required**

8 Before accepting a dog from any person, a research or
10 teaching institution of higher education subject to this chapter
12 must require that the person delivering the dog show proof of
14 ownership of that dog.

16 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

18 This bill requires that research or teaching institutions of
higher education that employ live animals in investigative
research or testing require proof of ownership of dogs before
accepting them.
