2 **Sec. 1. Review required. Resolved:** That the Department of
Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources in consultation with the
4 Department of Human Services shall review all rules applicable to
the licensing of small businesses and restaurants and prepare a
6 proposal to eliminate those rules that are duplicative or
conflicting and standardize all other rules regulating small
8 businesses and restaurants that are applicable to both the
Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources and the
Department of Human Services; and be it further

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Sec. 2. Report. Resolved: That the Department of Agriculture,
12 Food and Rural Resources and the Department of Human Services
shall report their proposal to the Joint Standing Committee on
14 Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry and the Joint Standing
Committee on Human Resources by January 1, 1996 before making any
16 rule change.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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 This resolve directs the Department of Agriculture, Food and
22 Rural Resources and the Department of Human Services to review
their rules applicable to the licensing of small businesses and
24 restaurants and to prepare a proposal to standardize those rules.
